
# Hammond Regional Arts Center Marjorie Morrison Sculpture Biennial April 12 - May 30, 2024

# SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

For consideration of inclusion, please digitally submit the following:

- Up to 3 artworks, 2 photographs of each max
- Title, date, medium, and price for each work
- Artist's statement
- Artist's bio
- Artist's headshot (for marketing purposes)

Works must be 3-D, and available for display for the entire exhibition, and ready for professional display.

# **ELIGIBILITY**

This exhibition is open to artists 18 years and older, with original 3-D work in mixed media, sculpture, ceramic, pottery, metal and woodwork.

# **DELIVERY OF WORKS**

All selected works must be delivered to HRAC by no later than 2 p.m. on Monday, April 8, 2024. HRAC reserves the right to disqualify any works which do not arrive by the stated deadline or ready for professional display.

# SHIPPING/DELIVERY

Shipping/delivery is the responsibility of the artist. If an item is shipped, a pre-paid return label must be included with the work(s). Any artist shipping work is responsible for insuring their pieces during shipment. HRAC is not responsible or liable for any damages occurring during shipping. While works are at HRAC, they will be insured for the declared value (sale price) only.

# **INSTALLATION**

Work must arrive ready to install. Curator Ryan Gianelloni and the HRAC staff will be responsible for exhibition layout, lighting, and basic installation. In cases where artwork exceeds basic installation, artists may be called upon to assist in installation. It is the responsibility of the artist to communicate and provide any special installation needs, including: instructions, tools, equipment, etc.

#### AGREEMENT TO TERMS

Submission of work(s) by an artist indicates full agreement to the terms laid out in this prospectus. Any questions or concerns regarding this document must be discussed prior to submission. Upon successfully completing the submission process, artists are expected to cooperate fully. Further agreements in the form of a completed and signed contract will be required for acceptance and display of the work(s) to be finalized.

#### **SALES**

All work displayed must be for sale. HRAC retains a 35% commission on all artwork sold. Artists are encouraged to price work in such a way that promotes sales, while simultaneously taking into account HRAC's nominal commission structure.

# DEINSTALLATION/SHIPPING

Work not collected after 90 days past the close of the exhibition will be considered abandoned and the property of HRAC. If an item is shipped, a pre-paid return label must be included with the work(s). Any artist shipping work is responsible for insuring their pieces during shipment. HRAC is not responsible or liable for any damages occurring during shipping.
